The association

The World Association for Laser Therapy was formed in 1994 in Barcelona, Spain, when two international organizations, namely, *International Laser Therapy Association (ILTA)* and *International Society for Laser Application in Medicine (ISLAM)*, unified to pursue the common goals of promoting research, education and clinical application of laser photostimulation world-wide.

The congresses have then been held in Jerusalem, Israel (1996); Kansas City, USA (1998); Athens, Greece (2000); Tsukuba, Japan (2002); Guarujá, SP, Brazil (2004); Lemesos, Cyprus (2006); and Sun City, South Africa (2008). The next congress will be held in Bergen, Norway in 2010.

The journal

Photomedicine and Laser Surgery is the official journal of the World Association for Laser Therapy and it is the leading photomedical scientific journal. It is indexed in MEDLINE, Current Contents/Clinical Medicine, and EMBASE/Excerpta Medica, among others. It has an impact factor of 1.3. Published 6 times a year, *Photomedicine and Laser Surgery* covers basic and clinical research, expanded applications, and procedures in medicine, surgery, dentistry, safety, new instrumentation, optical diagnostics, and the broad range of activities related to the understanding and applications of biophotonics in medicine.

Scientific Promotion

The Scientific Secretary leads the WALT Scientific Board, consisting of experts in fields like wound healing, dentistry, basic science, arthritis. The Scientific Committee is presenting recommendations for dosages, based on analyses of the available scientific literature. These recommendations can be found on the WALT website. The Scientific Committee is also active in improving the design of laser research and correcting flaws and misunderstandings in the literature. The Board is also available as consultants and advisors.
