Important new techniques, not testing some explicit hypotheses or reporting original findings, may be considered for publication as a technical report. Anecdotal non-experimental reports may be accepted for publication only if, in the opinion of the editors, they include enough details to stimulate well designed original research studies on the topic, or the paper seems useful to the general readership in reporting a previously unknown aspect of laser therapy. The criteria for acceptance of manuscripts include research excellence, novelty of idea, significance of the work, clarity and precision of writing, interest to the readership, and above all, a positive review by at least two experts identified by the editors. A "Product Review" section giving details of new therapeutic laser equipment and publications available on the market is published on occasion. Relevant books submitted to the editors are reviewed and published on a case by case basis.
